Welcome to the 2021 season of netball with Queenscliff Netball Club (QNC). All registrations for the 2021 winter season must be done online via www.queenscliffnetball.asn.au

Registration opens for all age groups on 10 January 2021
Registration closes on different dates as per below: Juniors – Friday 5 February 2021
Net Set Go – Thursday 18 February
Cadets – Thursday 18 February
Seniors & Mixed & O/35 Years – Thursday 18 February

LATE REGO

Late registrations will only be accepted if there are team positions available and will incur an additional \$20 processing fee.

Late Registration will not open until late March.

AGE GROUPS

The age group is determined by the age you turn this calendar year eg. Turning 12 years in 2021 = Playing in the U12s age group. 8 & 9 years age groups are now referred to as NetSetGo. 10-17 years age groups as Juniors or Cadets and 18+ years as Cadets, Seniors, Masters (O35) or Mixed.

It is important to register in the correct group for insurance purposes as Over 18's pay a higher insurance fee.

NetSetGo U8 and U9 years age groups are not graded and play modified rules in non-competiton games ie. no scores are recorded and there are no finals. U8 & U9 Players MUST play in the Net Set Go competition. Further we cannot register U6 or U7 Players in the Net Set Go competition. This is a MWNA Policy.

All other age groups play normal netball rules in teams selected by the Club and graded into competitions by the Manly Warringah Netball Association (MWNA).

REGISTRATION FEES

2021 Registration Fee is the same across ALL PLAYERS IRRESPECTIVE OF AGE OR DIVISION.

ALL PLAYERS \$200 per player *plus an additional payment processing fee of 31c fixed plus 2.00% per online transaction. •

ACTIVE KIDS REBATE

Active Kids is a program to help NSW families meet the cost of getting their kids into sport and active fitness and recreation activities. The NSW Government will provide a \$100 voucher to parents/guardians of school enrolled children. The \$100 voucher can be used for registration and participation costs for sport and fitness activities. The initiative aims to reduce barriers to participation and help change the physical activity behaviours of children and young people in NSW. MY NETBALL

- When you reach the My Netball ONLINE REGISTRATION page you will be required to LOG IN.
- If you are registering an EXISTING player, you will need to use their LOG IN ID & PASSWORD as provided in previous years.
- If the Player you are registering is NEW to Netball, you will need to get a LOG IN ID & PASSWORD. Please click the "DON'T HAVE A LOG IN ID" link and NSW Netball will issue with a LOG IN ID and Password before you can commence Registration.
- If you have FORGOTTEN your ID, please click on the "FOGOTTEN LOG IN" link and you will be taken through a process to find the ID.

All returning players will have an ID in the system.

Please Note, you must use the player's name and date of birth, NOT that of the parent when locating your ID if its been forgotten. You will find your ID very quickly but may need to create a new Password. Once logged in the rest of the process should be straightforward, just follow the instructions and answer all the questions. If you are struggling to find your Netball ID details, contact your relevant Registrar. Contact Details on the website.

You cannot register to play without ensuring your have an ID and paying for your Registration through MyNetball. In accordance with NSW Netball Guidelines unfortunately we cannot provide physical registration any longer.

REGISTRATION TERMS & CONDITIONS

The terms and conditions of registration are clearly spelled out on the QNC website and in the online forms. You must agree to abide by the ;

If you don't agree with these Policies, please do not register yourself or your child! By registering – you have ticked boxes that accept them.

PLAYER WITHDRAWALS & REFUNDS

Once registered, any refunds for player withdrawal will only be given before 28 February 2021. After this date, refunds can only be given for medical reasons and will require a medical certificate sent to the Club Secretary. After the above published date QNC are charged for the player and cannot get a refund. We cannot provide refunds until MWNA have approved the refund. Sometimes only partial refunds are provided. Each case is decided separately.

PLAYING TIME SLOTS FOR 2021

Playing times in 2021 have been DRAFTED. Please note, that as per 2020, we are at the mercy of Covid-19 and should the Government introduce parameters for Netball to work within the Competition structure may change. Refunds will not be provided based on the change of timings after 28 February 2021.

There are two version of the competition as at Dec 2020 that MWNA are working towards.

- 1. The 3 Hub Principle in line with 2020
- 2. 3000 participants permitted

Please review both schedules and be comfortable with potentially playing in line with *either*. All details are provided on our website.

REQUIRED DOCUMENTATION for ALL PLAYERS

In 2021 we will require a copy of a Passport or Birth Certificate for all new players and for **all U10 players** – regardless of whether they are new or not. U/10 Players will need to provide a copy at Grading.

All other players will be required to scan and submit a copy after registering.

UMPIRING

The MWNA competition will be Umpire Your Own again in 2021. All players in the U12s age group and above are required to assist with team umpiring duties as determined by the Manly Warringah Netball Association (MWNA) umpiring roster.

Fulfilment of these umpiring duties is a condition of registration for 12 years and older players. Parent Mentoring of these young Umpires is a condition of registration.

The presence of parents during the umpiring duties of their chid is expected and a responsibility as a result of your child's registration with QNC. This is not an opportunity to drop your child and return later. These young Umpires benefit from having a parent of guardian present, if nothing else but to let them know that they are doing well, trying their best and help build their confidence. The Club has a published list of mentors available at the start of each Season. If you feel that your young Umpire needs more assistance than

you are able to provide, these Mentors can be accessed. There is a fee associated and the organisation and payment is made directly with the Mentor. All Mentors have been approved by the Club Umpiring Convenor. Parents may use their own Mentors if they so choose.

Parents are STILL expected to be present during the allocated Umpiring Duty for support.

Further, the mentoring of your Umpires should not fall on the shoulders of Club Coaches and Managers. Parents must take responsibility and the list of Mentors mentioned previously is accessible well in advance. Umpires, whose parents do not accompany them to Games, will not be permitted to registrar with the Club in future seasons.

Umpiring Pathways towards C Grade Badges is a Program that players should indicate they are interested in, so that Mentoring can be organized.

PHOTO ID CARDS

MWNA use photo ID's for all teams in the U/10 competition and above. Signatures are NOT required on these cards but players will need to sign the scoresheets for each game and sign a master sheet at the commencement of Game 1. All NEW players U10 yrs and above must supply a digital photo file in order to complete their registration.

Unfortunately you cannot attach the file directly to your MyNetball rego within MyNetball at this stage. This will therefore be a 2-part process: First you will need to register in MyNetball as described above. Second, once teams have been announced in mid February and coaches and managers appointed for each team you must then email your photo file to your team coach and/or manager. The coach or manager will send all the photo files for their team as a group to the Registrar.

COMPULSORY CLUB GRADING DATES

All players in the U/10 - U/14 years age groups inclusive MUST attend the relevant Club grading session as follows.

Grading U10 & U11 - 7 Feb between 1-5pm. Specific Timeslot to be advised based on age group numbers.

Grading U12 & U13 - 14 Feb between 1-5pm. Specific Timeslot to be advised based on age group numbers.

Grading U10 & U11 - 21 Feb between 1-5pm. Specific Timeslot to be advised based on age group numbers.

U14 & U15 - Paper Grading at this stage

MWNA U10 & U11 Grading Day - 21 March
** ALL GRADING WILL TAKE PLACE AT PCYC, DEE WHY (INDOOR CNT)

MWNA 10 YEARS & 11 YEARS GRADING ROUND-ROBIN (COMPULSORY)

Please note the U10 Age Group has a further mandatory MWNA Grading Day. This day involves all U10 & U11 Queenscliff Teams playing against other and other Clubs and allows MWNA Graders the opportunity to grade the entire U10 & U11 Age Groups for the Winter Season. This is a very important day for all QNC Teams as the outcomes dictate the grade for the Winter Season. Attendance is mandatory and this year falls on 21 March. U10s will likely be needed in the AM and U11's in the PM.

UNIFORMS

In 2021 our Uniform allocation will work a little differently to remove the need for someone to store copious qty of product at their home and have endless one on one fittings with players.

Our Uniform Days will be <u>Sat 7 & Sat 14 Feb</u> 2021 at PCYC whilst Grading is taking place. 1-4pm both days and with likely Covid restrictions in place, bookings will be essential.

Following this any orders will take place online and will take up to 3 business days to process and be available for Pick Up. Orders will not be mailed. All orders will be via our website www.queenscliffnetball.asn.au

As a reminder our Playing Uniform includes a Playing Dress, Nixz Bike Shorts in QNC Royal Blue and QNC Socks. All of these and our hoodies, track pants, new visors and sideline jackets will be available for sale in February.

We are an amateur sports club run by volunteers and can only provide coaches and managers for teams if people volunteer their time. Please consider helping your child's team by volunteering to coach or manage on the registration form.
